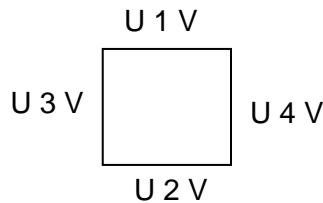


LES LANCIERS I
“Les Tiroirs”
The Drawers



A Balance

- Meas. 1-2 Greet Partner
 3-4 and corner
 5-6 Turn to partner and balance right and left
 7-8 Under joined inside hands, women turn once CCW with 4 steps.
 9-10 With inside hands joined partners face center of set

B Head Couples Greet, Ladies Hand Tour

- Meas. 1-2 Head couples, inside hands joined beginning R, 4 steps to center
 Greet opposite couple
 3-4 4 walking steps bkw to original place. Release hold
 5-8 Head ladies give R hands in shoulder heights and turn once CW
 Release hold and go backwards to place

C Head Couples Change places and Back

- Meas. 1-3 Couple #1, with inside hands joined and stretched out, goes “with 6 steps through couple #2 to opposite place. (They go *tight*) At the same time couple #2 separates to let couple # 1 through and goes to the opposite place (they go *wide*)
 4 Couple # 1 releases hold and turns away from each other to return to original place going *wide*. Couple #2 takes *tight* position to return to original place
 5-8 Repeat as above, but couple #2 goes *tight* and # 1 goes *wide*
 Both couples turn toward partners to face center of circle.



A Balance and Hand Tour with Corner

- Meas. 1-4 Each turns to corner and balances right and left 2x
 5-8 With 8 steps right hand tour with corner partner

Repeat with Side Couples

- B Greeting of side couples, ladies hand tour
 C Side couples cross over and back (couple # 3 tight)
 A Balance and hand tour with corner

BCA Then the **head couples repeat** sequence (couple # 2 tight)

BCA Then the **side couples repeat** sequence (couple # 4 tight)
